Both parties recognise the importance of effective and efficient education solutions that helps boxers' knowledge towards anti-doping practices, systems, structures and testing methods.

It is of high importance that every boxer that competes at the 2012 Australian Championships has an understanding of ASADA. Therefore if a boxer hasn't received any ASADA education in the past 12 months, Boxing Australia is encouraging you to register and commence ASADA's eLearning before competing at the 2012 Australian Championships.

Any boxer competing at the Australian Championships will be in the Registered Testing Pooling, and is eligible at any time to be randomly tested by ASADA officials
